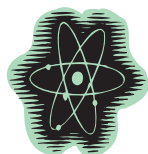

I have been turned into the authorities and am about to be carried off for Lock Up. I don't know who did it, but if I find out ... Someone had the bright idea to give my name to the Muscular Dystrophy Association and now I have to raise bail. On June 23rd they will come to "arrest " me and take me to lock up. An actual police officer will come to the church at 10:00 and put me in hand cuffs and haul me away. I am quite certain the staff will have cameras in hand and post pictures to the church web. Here's the thing - I know that this was done by someone in the church. How do I know? There are not very many folk outside of John Wesley UMC that know me in the Charleston area. And, I have seen the list of all those who are being arrested. Not one other Methodist Pastor, in fact not one other pastor at all is on the list. Put those two things together and ergo ... it had to be someone here. Soooo..I will be going, but I am not going quietly. I'm taking the church directory with me. And I am calling everyone on the list to help raise my bail. My goal is \$2,400.00. To avoid a phone call, you can make a donation to my bail early. Please do this before June 23 so I can take my bail with me. Remember donations are tax deductible. The funds go to research and support of families of children dealing with Muscular Dystrophy. My incarceration will be at the Comfort Suites West Ashley. They promise food and fun and maybe even a poolside phone to call you all. Meanwhile, I will be searching out the culprit.....

The search criteria used included persons who would be in the U.S. during the summer and then be returning to the field.

The search concluded with Sara Flores and Dakin Cook. Both have been working in New York at the general offices of the Board of Global Ministries of the UMC. This fall they will be returning to the field; Dakin will be in South America as Regional Auditor. Sara will be working with South American churches in health and community development benefiting women, children and the elderly.

Sara and Dakin will be here at John Wesley on Sunday, June 6. They will lead the 8:30 a.m. service and present their work at the 6:00 p.m. Reflections service. Please plan to attend one of the services to hear of their work, to meet them in person, and to join with them as partners in missionary outreach to the world.
